New Articulation Agreements between SLTATC and SLCC

SALT LAKE CITY, UT – February 27, 2006 – A new articulation agreement for programs in Information Technologies has been signed by the Salt Lake • Tooele Applied Technology College (SLTATC) and the Salt Lake Community College (SLCC).

The articulation agreement allows students at the SLTATC who successfully complete Information Technology (I.T.) courses at those institutions to receive credit for major courses in the Telecommunications Technology AAS degree from SLCC. Under the agreement, students attending the SLCC Skills Center may also have their I.T. courses recognized for credit toward the AAS degree.

“This is tremendous benefit for students,” said Linda Fife, Campus President at the SLTATC. “They can begin their training at the Applied Technology College and, if they desire, transfer their completed coursework to the Community College where they can continue working toward an associate degree. This is an excellent example of the unique way our colleges can work together and complement each other in helping students achieve their academic goals.”

This is the second agreement signed by the two colleges. Both institutions signed an articulation agreement for Heavy-Duty Diesel Technologies in January. That agreement also allows students at the SLTATC to transfer their completed coursework to the SLCC for credit towards an AAS degree in Diesel Technologies.
